7010 · Administration	indirect costs that support the organization
7015 · Core Program Services	direct costs of serving clients
7020 · Programs-Employment Benefit	Labour Market-wage/subsidy/self-employment, public/non-public training
7020-1 · Training Public	Public post-secondary institutions such as UM, Red River, UW, etc.
7020-2 · Training Non-Public	Non-public private such as Academy of Learning, CDI College, Manitoba Heavy Construction Assoc., etc.
7020-3 · Job Creation	provide insured participants with opportunities to gain work experience that will lead to ongoing employment. Activities of the project help develop the community and the local economy
7020-4 · Self-Employment	financial assistance and business planning advice to EI-eligible participants to help them start their own business
7020-5 · Wage Subsidy	provide financial assistance to non-profit, private and public organizations to enable them to deliver varied services to unemployed individuals who wish to enter and stay in the labour force
7020-6 · Other Labour Market Programs	developing plans and strategies, and implementing labour force adjustment measures
7025 · Employment Support Measures	provide employment assistance to unemployed persons-include individual counselling, action planning, job search skills, job finding clubs, job placement services, the provision of labour market information, case management and follow-up.
7025-1 · Employment Assisted Services	provide financial assistance to non-profit, private and public organizations to enable them to deliver varied services to unemployed individuals who wish to enter and stay in the labour force
7025-2 · Job Maintenance	assistance to gain employment
7025-3 · Participant Allowances	participant wages for attending programs
7025-4 · Supplementary Allowance	additional assistance to ensure program completion/ retention measure
7025-5 · Top Ups	top up of EI benefits
7025-6 · Other	miscellaneous costs that do not fit into other criteria
7030 · Employment & Training-Youth	design, develop & deliver unique partnership-based & demand-driven youth programs
7035 · Employment & Training-Disabled	enhance skills & employment services for people with disabilities
7040 · Capital Costs-Daycare	licensing & capital purchases for community daycares
7045 · Capital Costs-Other	capital costs for communities
7050 · Partnership Development	salary for staff that create/maintain partnerships & travel costs for attending partnership meetings

To be eligible for Employment Benefits, individuals must be unemployed and have a current EI claim as an "active EI client" or a claim that ended in the preceding three years as a "former EI client"
