DESIGNATION OF RECIPIENT AS REFERRAL AUTHORITY

1. To better coordinate the provision of assistance by the Recipient to participants in its programs who are active EI claimants with the payment of insurance benefits to those claimants by virtue of section 25 of the *Employment Insurance Act*, Canada, as represented by the Canada Employment Insurance Commission, hereby designates the Recipient as an authority for the purposes of section 25 of the *Employment Insurance Act* to refer participants in the Recipient's activities who are active EI claimants to:
 - (a) courses or programs of instruction or training which the claimant is attending at his or her own expense; or
 - (b) any other employment activity for which assistance has been provided for the claimant under labour market programs described in the annual operational plan (Schedule C) which are similar to the Self-employment Employment Benefit and the Job Creation Partnerships Employment Benefit established by the Commission under the *Act*.
2. In making any referrals referred to in subsection (1), the Recipient shall comply with such policies regarding the referral of claimants for the purposes of section 25 of the *Employment Insurance Act* that Canada, as represented by the Canada Employment Insurance Commission, may issue from time to time.
3. The designation of the Recipient under this section shall terminate automatically on expiry of the Period of the Agreement. The Commission may also revoke the designation at any time for cause.
